



# Appointment to the Great Lakes Pilotage Authority

OTTAWA — The Honourable Denis Lebel, Minister of Transport, Infrastructure and Communities, today announced the appointment of Mr. David Grieve of Saint-Lazare, Quebec, to the board of directors of the Great Lakes Pilotage Authority for a three-year term, effective December 15, 2011.
