Mr. Robert Lemire, Chief Executive Officer of the Great Lakes Pilotage Authority (GLPA), wishes to announce that the Minister of Transport, Mr. Marc Garneau, has recently appointed Ms. Danièle Dion to Chairperson of the GLPA for a five-year period.
