

HOW TO REQUEST A PILOT

1. REQUIRED INFORMATION FOR ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:

- Name of the vessel;
- Call sign;
- Nationality of the vessel;
- Length overall;
- Breadth;
- Moulded depth;
- Gross tonnage;
- Deepest draft;
- Sea speed;
- Origin;
- Destination;
- Agent of the ship.

2. SHIPS UPBOUND ENTERING THE SEAWAY AT ST-LAMBERT LOCK:

- Provide 12 hours notice before the ship's estimated time of arrival at St-Lambert Lock;
- Confirm the pilot requirement six (6) hours before the ship's estimated time of arrival at St-Lambert Lock.

3. SHIPS DEPARTING ANY PORT WITHIN THE GREAT LAKES REGION:

- Provide 12 hours notice before the ship's estimated time of departure from a Great Lakes Region port;
- Confirm the pilot requirement six (6) hours before the ship's estimated time of departure.
